  - Name of Teacher
  - School's Address
2. Each student may only submit one entry (Schools are encouraged to submit all entries that it receives to the district)
3. The entries must be delivered to the Clarendon Soil and Water Conservation District office by 4:30pm on Friday, November 12, 2010.



## Judging/Awards:

1. Poems will be judged on originality, neatness, and overall effectiveness of the message.
2. A county winner in each grade level will be chosen
3. The first place county winner in each grade level will receive \$20 and a certificate.
4. Awards will be presented to the winners at a date designated by the teacher.
