Guidelines:

1. All essays must have the following information on a separate, but attached sheet of paper:
 - Name of Student
 - Grade
 - Student's Address
 - Name of School
 - Name of Teacher
 - School's Address
2. Essays must be legible! Typed or printed double space is preferred, but neatly handwritten in ink on the front side of paper is acceptable.
3. Essays should contain 300-500 words
4. All entries must be delivered to the Clarendon Soil and Water Conservation District office by 4:30pm on **Friday, April 8, 2011**.
5. All entries become the property of Clarendon Soil & Water Conservation District.
6. Essays will be judged within each grade level. Each school will have a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner in each grade level.
7. Prizes are \$30 for 1st place, \$20 for 2nd place, and \$15 for 3rd place.
8. All teachers who have students enter the contest will have their names placed into a drawing for a \$100 gift card to wal-mart (for help in purchasing school supplies).
