Guidelines:

1. All posters must have the following information written on the back in waterproof marker:
 - Name of School
 - Grade
 - Name of Teacher
 - School's Address
 - School's Phone Number
 - Names of all students in class
2. Posters are to be no larger than 36" x 48" and should be easily transportable, designed for all display and able to withstand stacking and handling. Oversized Posters will not be judged!
3. Posters are a class/group effort. Poster should be student work and use the creativity and efforts of all group members.
4. All entries must be delivered to the Clarendon Soil and Water Conservation District office by 4:30pm on **Friday, April 8, 2011.**
5. All entries become the property of Clarendon Soil & Water Conservation District.
6. Posters will be judged within each grade level.
